### Use native and adaptive plants

### Take shorter showers

Let's see how fast you can shower. Try using a timer in your shower and set it for five minutes. Cut your shower from 10 minutes to 5 and you could save more than 10 gallons of water. Every day!



### Stop that running toilet!

A running toilet can waste up to 200 gallons of water a day. Try the food coloring test. Put a few drops of food coloring in the tank. If the water in the bowl changes color, you have a leak! Usually it's easy to fix with simple tools and a part from the hardware store.
